NOTES:

- 1. Club nights consist of a special event (eg. 200m medley, 100m freestyle) followed by each of the four strokes (25m or 50m).
- 2. Nominations are made through Swim Central (accessed on the club website).
- 3. Dates are subject to change.
- 4. Swimmers must swim 9 club nights to be eligible for age champion points at the Club Championships.
- 5. **Elaine Goebel Relay:** The Elaine Goebel Relay is a knock out teams relay event where teams compete to try and record consistent team times each time they race.

Rules for the Elaine Goebel Relay are as follows:

- Swimmers are placed in mixed teams (male and female) of equal numbers.
- Round 1: Teams swim a relay to record an overall team time.
- Subsequent Rounds: Teams swim the relay and record an overall time. The team which records a time furthest from their overall time in Round 1 is eliminated. Rounds continue until one team is declared the winner.
- The winning team is kept secret until Club Presentations and will receive a medal / team names on a trophy.
