- Age champions will be decided from the 50m events. To be eligible for age champion, swimmers must swim all 4x 50m events.
- Medals for 1st, 2nd & 3rd will be awarded in all events except for 7 and under events.
- All heats will be swum as Timed finals.
- Netpro Skins event - Girls & Boys must have nominated in at least 4 events to qualify.
- The meet will be operated under current COVID regulations and will be strictly adhered to.
- **RELAYS:** All clubs are invited to participate in the relay event at the end of the meet. Nominations will be **accepted on the day** - \$5 per team. Mixed 12yrs & under and Mixed 13yrs & over \$60 cash prize.

2023 STANTHORPE OPEN SPRINT TRANSITION MEET

Sunday 29th January 2023

All events will be conducted under SQ rules.

One start rule will apply.

Self-Marshalling will be used at this event.

Swimmers must swim in their allocated lane unless otherwise directed.

Placegetters - First, Second and Third in all events will be judged on the times swum in any heat, and these swimmers will receive medallions. No finals will be swum. Excluding 7 & Under Age group.

No unauthorized person is to stand on the concourse after the commencement of the meet.

Competitors moving around the pool concourse must ensure they do not interfere with the officials' ability to conduct their specific duties.

The smaller swimming pool / wading pool are NOT to be used by competitors or non-competitors while the meet is in progress.

Timekeepers will not give swimmers their times. Times will be posted on notice boards in the pool area. Meet Mobile will be in use.

The Referee will settle all disputes that may arise within his/her jurisdiction and his/her decision will be final.

Age of swimmer is actual age on day of carnival.

The boy and girl of each age division obtaining the greatest number of points will receive Age Champion Awards. To qualify for Age Champion points, a swimmer must have competed in all 50m four strokes at the meet. In case of a tie, times will be added up and winner will be the lower (fastest) time. Please note 7 & under swimmers will all receive a participation ribbon/medallion on the day

A nomination fee of **\$6.50** plus applicable fees per event through Swim Central.

Semi-electronic timing equipment will be used

Nominations close on 23/01/23. Late nominations will not be accepted.

A SKINS event will be held with a total prize pool of \$500. Swimmers who compete in 4 Individual events and are in the top 8 fastest 50m freestyle boys and girls will be eligible to compete.

The Stanthorpe Pool is located in Weeroona Park, entry via Talc Street. Car Park available. The pool is an 8 lane 50m, with shallow ends, 1.1m, at either end, 2m in the middle of the pool. **SHALLOW DIVE ONLY.**

There are shaded areas and a grandstand, with areas available for shade tents.

The swimming club will run a BBQ and raffles throughout the day. The program will be available on the DDRSA website.
